The Town held another successful Annual Community Day on June 8th! The organization committee would like to thank all those involved in the annual event. The committee would like to thank all those groups and individuals putting floats in the parade. We appreciate all those individuals who participated in the street market and ran events during the course of the day. The more community organizations take on events the better Community Days will be. Plans are underway for next year! If you want to get involved with the committee please let the Town Office know.

We would like to welcome our summer student Zach Plant to the Public Works Crew. He will have various duties during the summer and will help to maintain the grass cutting and other tasks. If you see Zach around in the next few weeks say hi!

In the last budget, the Council committed to allocating money to the resurfacing of the Service Road. We do not have an exact date for the work to begin but will provide residents with notice in advance so individuals can make alternate route choices. With summer also comes road repair. The Town has been working on fixing frost boils. Currently the Town is busy with 2nd Street East.

The Town will also be continuing with SB90 this year. We have had many compliments about the roads that have the product on them. The SB90 product graded and reapplied with more product to remove the bumps and rough spots. The Town will reassess the areas and fix all necessary problem spots.

During the summer, the town will be removing uneven sidewalks and has started with replacement of some that were beyond repair. Please watch for more details in the coming days.

The Skatepark continues to be a popular place for kids of all ages. The Town has installed two garbage cans so we encourage people to use them! The town repaired the existing sidewalk in front of the Old High School. The existing sidewalk was extended to connect the park to the existing sidewalks. During the summer, topsoil will be brought in and grass will be planted in the areas around the sidewalk. The improvements to the park continue as we make this space a hub of activity for kids of all ages.

The Town of Lashburn would like to remind town residents that your personal property such as boats, campers, utility trailers etc. cannot be parked on town owned lots or boulevards for extended periods of time, this includes motor homes.

Camper Pullouts are not allowed to jut out over sidewalks or into the street.

Unlicensed or partly dismantled vehicles cannot be parked on the street or town boulevards at any time.

Any time any type of trailer is parked on a town street it must be licensed and attached to a currently licensed vehicle for transporting. Parking vehicles where it impedes sight of moving traffic at intersections is prohibited.

No parking within 5 meters of any intersection or fire hydrant.

Anything in contravention of the Town's Bylaw is liable to a \$100.00 fine and unit may be towed and impounded.


