The Community Day celebration is only a few weeks away! The organization committee is happy with the participation of community groups. This year there will be several new attractions for your enjoyment. If you have not yet registered your float, please call the Town Office as soon as possible. This allows for a more organized placement of floats on Saturday morning at the Community Hall. There is still time if you are interested in becoming part of the day. As summer fast approaches and residents start to enjoy the outdoors we would like to stress the need to be neighbourly and respectful of other residents. We would encourage you to observe the town noise bylaws and recreational bylaws. Please remember that ATV's are not permitted in Town.

The Town will be starting to fix frost boils on various roads. There are a few large ones, which need immediate attention. We will continue working on them in the coming weeks. The Town will be continuing to apply SB90 product to the streets in Lashburn. This has tentatively been booked for June 2019. It is a costly process to apply dust proof and as a result it will happen only once during the spring/early summer.

The Community in Blooms organization will soon be preparing the flowerbeds and garden areas in the next few weeks. If you were interested in becoming involved, I would encourage you to leave your name and phone number at the Town Office.

We also would like to remind residents about the parking of recreational vehicles on the street. The town allows the parking of campers on streets for loading purposes, but the street or town boulevard should not be used as long-term storage for trailers. In addition, if parking on the street, please do not leave your pullouts extended as it could become a potential hazard for drivers.

Within the next few days, the Council will be sending out a detailed update in regards to the 2019 town budget.

The Town of Lashburn would like to remind town residents that your personal property such as boats, campers, utility trailers etc. cannot be parked on town owned lots or boulevards for extended periods of time, this includes motor homes. Camper Pullouts are not allowed to jut out over sidewalks or into the street. Unlicensed or partly dismantled vehicles cannot be parked on the street or town boulevards at any time.

Any time any type of trailer is parked on a town street it must be licensed and attached to a currently licensed vehicle for transporting. Parking vehicles where it impedes sight of moving traffic at intersections is prohibited. No parking within 5 meters of any intersection or fire hydrant.

Anything in contravention of the Town's Bylaw is liable to a \$100.00 fine and unit may be towed and impounded.
