Minute with the Mayor

November, 2019

The Town has been able to complete two major projects this fall. The replacement and repair of water lines and curb stops has been completed on Main Street. The service road was also resurfaced. More work will be completed in the spring to deal with the pooling of water in the intersection. Thank you for your cooperation and understanding during construction.

The Town has also been discussing possible options of an alternate water source involving SaskWater and a Regional pipeline. Council has discussed the issue and attended several meetings on the project. The Town will hold a public meeting in the new year to present information to the public. SaskWater will also be at the meeting. When a date is decided we will inform the public as feedback is important in the process.

Town Council would like to thank the Lashburn Legion Branch for holding the Remembrance Day Service on November 11th. The community appreciates your efforts. We know with each passing year there are fewer and fewer veterans and with a small legion membership they continue to organize this important ceremony of remembrance in our community.

Councillor Covey and I attended the Annual Meeting of the Legacy Regional Protective Services in Lloydminster on October 29th. The Town of Lashburn is a member of the Regional fire protection and rescue services and as a result have two members sitting on the Fire Board. The Town believes the move to the Regional Service has been a huge plus for the Community and the protection of our citizens. The Town looks forward to the continued growth of Legacy Regional Protective Services as it continues to adapt to the needs of our area.



The Town of Lashburn would like to remind town residents that your personal property such as boats, campers, utility trailers etc. cannot be parked on town owned lots or boulevards for extended periods of time, this includes motor homes. Camper Pullouts are not allowed to jut out over sidewalks or into the street.

Unlicensed or partly dismantled vehicles cannot be parked on the street or town boulevards at any time.

Any time any type of trailer is parked on a town street it must be licensed and attached to a currently licensed vehicle for transporting. Parking vehicles where it impedes sight of moving traffic at intersections is prohibited.

No parking within 5 meters of any intersection or fire hydrant.

Anything in contravention of the Town's Bylaw is liable to a \$100.00 fine and unit may be towed and impounded.
