August

Summer is quickly making its way into fall. Hope you still have some time to enjoy the beautiful weather we are having in August.

As stated in the spring the Town Council has made the improvement of the streets in Lashburn a top priority. This summer we have completed SB90 on a few more streets. The product is costly and we can only budget for a few streets each year. Council is happy with the product and will continue to surface the streets in a timely fashion. We appreciate your patients and cooperation as we work to improve our streets.

I would like to take this time to thank Braden Holtby for bringing the Stanley Cup to Lashburn. It was a great recognition for the years you spent in minor hockey in our community. I know that the one hour session with minor players was a definite highlight for many. I would like to extend a special thank you to the Lashburn Arena Board for organizing the event.

With the end of summer holidays also comes the return of school and children walking to and from school. Please remember to reduce your speed in the school zones.

The placement of the skate park will continue in the next few weeks. We are attempting to get the remaining pieces out as soon as possible. Living quite close to Heritage Park I know that the four pieces that have been placed have been quite popular with kids. It is a busy place at all times of the day. The Town will also be placing garbage cans close to the skate park for people's convenience. Also, in the coming weeks the Public Works employees will be reassembling the outdoor rink so it can be ready to go when the season starts. Town Council is quite pleased with the transformation of Heritage Park into a multi-purpose area for kids and families to enjoy. If you have any suggestions please do not hesitate to forward them to Town Council.

Over the summer Councilor Bryce, our Town Administrator and I had the opportunity to meet with MP Rosemarie Falk for a discussion in the Town Office. We had a great discussion on several topics ranging from the summer jobs program, policing, grants, infrastructure funding and much more. In the 10 years or so I have been Mayor this is the first time our MP has taken the time to sit down with us. The time and conversation was appreciated!

In the next few days Councilor Covey and I will have an opportunity to meet with Ryan Meili the Leader of the Opposition in Saskatchewan. We hope to have the opportunity to discuss infrastructure funding, provincial grants, policing and other topics. It is another great opportunity to add our community's voice to address problem areas in our Province.

As outlined in the Town development plan we would like to create a walking trail system in the community. I have been in discussions with a corporate investor and I am hoping we can come up with a long term plan. Our hope is the walking trails will be able to incorporate some of the many areas in our community highlighting nature beauty and the history of our community. If you have any suggestions or would like be involved please do not hesitate to contact me. Each new thing we develop in our Town makes our community that much better.
